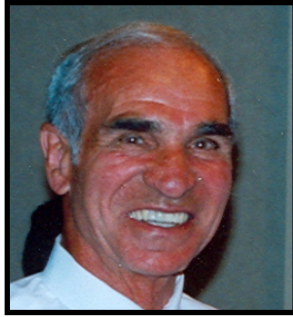

JOHN A. CARUSO 2009 ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

ELIGIBILITY

High School seniors attending any Warwick High School who are residents of the City of Warwick and plan to pursue a career in pure or applied sciences, environmental studies or engineering.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

One-year scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each, one scholarship per school, to be paid directly to the post-secondary institution(s) to which the awardees are enrolled.

APPLICATION SUBMITTAL

The application submittal package must include:

1. A completed 2009 Annual Scholarship Award Application Form
2. Proof of the student's acceptance at any post-secondary institution accredited by the National Association of Schools and Colleges and/or the Department of Education in the state where the institution is located. Applications may be made prior to receiving formal notification of acceptance to the post-secondary institution; however, all awards shall be withheld pending receipt of proof of acceptance, which would be a letter from the Registrar certifying that the applicant is registered and in good standing
3. Documentation of the student's financial need as determined by the confidential Parent's Scholarship Financial Statement
4. A copy of the student's High School transcript of grades
5. Letters of recommendation from the student's principal or guidance counselor, as well as, one from the student's academic teachers
6. Evidence of participation in extracurricular activities and/or community service
7. An essay (minimum 500 words) describing the student's chosen field of study, the reasons for this career choice and the goals that the student wishes to achieve in this elected field
