RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION STUDY THE NEED FOR A CROSSWALK AND/OR A
CAUTION LIGHT ON POST ROAD NEAR THE GREENWOOD CREDIT UNION

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the Warwick City Council; and,

WHEREAS, Post Road in the area of the Greenwood Bridge is heavily traveled by vehicular traffic; and,

WHEREAS, heavy volume of vehicular traffic creates a hazard for pedestrians crossing Post Road in the area of the Greenwood Credit Union; and,

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Warwick City Council that Greenwood Credit Union may expand its operations from its current location to vacant land on the other side of Post Road; and,

WHEREAS, such an expansion would increase the danger to pedestrians attempting to cross Post Road in the vicinity of the credit union.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby requests that the State Department of Transportation study the need for a crosswalk/caution light on Post Road near the Greenwood Credit Union to protect pedestrians when they are crossing Post Road.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the State Department of Transportation.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
