**RESOLUTION REGARDING MEMBERSHIP OF THE
CITY CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted PCR-48-15 as R-15-107 establishing a City Charter Review Commission to study the composition of the school committee and how members are selected for the School Committee; term limits for elected officials; an increase to \$5000.00 in the amount for items that may be purchased without City Council approval; and any other sections of the Charter that the Commission finds should be studied; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to add positions for two alternates who could fill in if any regular members of the Commission are unavailable to attend a meeting of the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the two alternate positions be filled by Councilman Joseph Gallucci and Nathan Cornell; and

WHEREAS, the alternates will be available to attend Charter Review Commission meetings and will be counted for quorum purposes and will vote only if the alternate is filling in for a Commission member who is absent from a meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby adds two positions as alternates to City Charter Review Commission established by PCR-48-15 which became R-15-107; hereby appoints Councilman Joseph Gallucci and Nathan Cornell to the alternate positions. Said alternates will be available to attend Charter Review Commission meetings and will be counted for quorum purposes and will vote only if the alternate is filling in for a regular Commission member who is absent from a meeting

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the members of
