31. Discussion with Tariq Babar of Dan's Convenience, 2699 Post Road, as to why he is operating without a license.

Deputy Chief Babula: Essentially Dan's Convenience Store has not had a license since January 26th. I mean it's a routine convenience store business license. He just needs a food business license and a certificate of occupancy. Um, he's been in regular communication with Heather, our Licensing Clerk, and said he would bring these things in. She's been giving him more time, feeling that he was operating on good faith, but he still hasn't produced it. So, we felt it's best to ask him in and tell us.

Mr. Tariq Babar: No, I'm just waiting. All inspections are done except this electrical thing. So, the guy will be there maybe tomorrow or day after tomorrow, yes.

Chairwoman Baxter: Okay. So this hasn't been approved for issuance. So, there's still no CO, right?

Deputy Chief Babula: Do you have a food business license sir?

Mr. Babar: I applied there [inaudible] did the inspection. I have that. I applied on March 31st. Yes, right here. I [inaudible] a check. I'm still waiting for the inspections.

Chairwoman Baxter: Market cash registers, Department of Health. Is this what we need?

Deputy Chief Babula: That's what we're waiting for. What does it say ma'am?

Chairwoman Baxter hands the paper to the Deputy Chief.

Chairwoman Baxter: Yeah, okay, So you need...

Mr. Babar: Just electrical.

Chairwoman Baxter: Electrical.

Mr. Babar: Yeah the [inaudible] department. Two, three, four, five, six. I'm just waiting for electrical back, electrical inspector.

Chairwoman Baxter: Okay, but these are all dated April.

Mr. Babar: These are date, yeah. These are done. These inspections are done. These are passed. Just one electrical is left.

Chairwoman Baxter: I know, I'm just saying they're all dated April and this has been since January.

Mr. Babar: No, because I, this is my first business in this town and I didn't know about this certificate of occupancy. I had no idea. When I got this letter then I figured it out what's going on.

Vice Chairman Paolucci: What's the date on the letter?

Mr. Babar: March 22nd.

Chairwoman Baxter: March 22nd, okay. That's Heather's email, is also March 22nd.

Deputy Chief Babula: Yes, and we feel that Mr. Babar is acting in good faith. It's just that he's been without a valid license for three months and we wanted to ensure that he met these standards, essentially.

Chairwoman Baxter: Absolutely. So, that is what he needs.

Deputy Chief Babula: Uh - not entirely. He needs an actual business license. This is a check.

Mr. Babar: Actual business license, what is it? Actual business license I have from the state yes.

Deputy Chief Babula: That's what I'm talking about.

Mr. Babar: Yeah, yeah, we have.

Deputy Chief Babula: Uh, just produce a copy of that.

Mr. Babar: No, no. Since, um, [inaudible] I bought this business in November so I have license in November over there.

Deputy Chief Babula: Yeah, see it ran out on January 26th. You have to renew it.

Mr. Babar: No, that business license goes up to June. It expires in June.

Deputy Chief Babula: That's not indicated in our records.

Mr. Babar: Yeah, June 30th.

Vice Chairman Paolucci: Maybe that's the State one.

Mr. Babar: Yeah, all of the State licenses expire in June.

Chairwoman Baxter: The State licenses expire in June?

Vice Chairman Paolucci: I'm not sure what the requirements are.

Chairwoman Baxter: Can you get a copy of that to Heather in the Licensing Office here?

Mr. Babar: Yeah, sure. Sure. Sure.

Chairwoman Baxter: Okay, and we need that electrical. When is he coming to inspect? Do you know? The electrical person.

Mr. Babar: Electrical, maybe tomorrow or the day after tomorrow. Tomorrow morning I'll call him again. And this uh - I talked to this girl - and she said she will be there tomorrow between 8:30 and 9:00.

Clerk McGovern: [inaudible] food one.

Chairwoman Baxter: Food?

Mr. Babar: Well this is food protection, this is different.

Deputy Chief Babula: That's, that's what we've been waiting for. Food protection inspection and a copy of his business license from the State.

Chairwoman Baxter: Yeah this is the Health Department.

Deputy Chief Babula: The Health Department does the food safety inspection...

Mr. Babar [interposing]: Yeah, she will be there tomorrow between 8:00 and 8:30 and 9:00.

Chairwoman Baxter: And this is dated March 31st, okay.

Mr. Babar: Yeah, yeah.

Chairwoman Baxter: All right, so please give a copy of your business license to Heather, downstairs. Copy it and fax it or bring it over to here, okay?

Mr. Babar: Sure, okay I will.

Deputy Chief Babula: The proof of the certificate of occupation and the proof of the Health Department inspection of food. That's it, nothing else.

Chairwoman Baxter: Yes.

Mr. Babar: Sure.

Chairwoman Baxter: Okay, so when is our next meeting?

Recording Secretary Ferolito: May 10th.

Chairwoman Baxter: Okay, how about we need to see everything at the next meeting and then he's free and clear. Does that sound fair?


Vice Chairman Paolucci: Stay open until then. Keep operating.
