

**Minutes of Meeting  
Warwick Wildlife and Conservation Commission  
January 21, 2016**

Chair Anne Holst called the meeting of the Warwick Wildlife and Conservation Commission to order at 7:03PM. Members in attendance were Wayne Cabral, Ray Meunier, and Mike Clark and Sue Cabeceiras from the Planning Department.

A motion to accept the minutes of the December 2015 meeting was made by Wayne, seconded by Ray and unanimously approved.

Anne reported that she had spoken with Martha Cruciani who informed her that Metropolitan Insurance had sold the property with the pond on it, adjacent to the Jesse P. Dawley Memorial Woodland. Martha said there was a 15 year lease on the property and she will find out who the new owners are.

Ray saw an excavator up at Barton Farm presumably to remove the debris from the barn that was torn down.

Wayne reported that the Chepiwanoxet Point looks good. Residents are keeping it up and the DPW is picking up the trash.

Anne and Wayne put together the computerized Blueways paddle maps drafts for review. There was a question of where to put the maps on the documents.

The Commissioners discussed the press event to be held Saturday January 30<sup>th</sup> working with the Boy Scouts to build and install wood duck/ bat/bird boxes. Sue drafted the press release that was approved with minor changes, and she will send it to the Mayor's press secretary for release. Ray suggested the Commissioners all register to become a Certified NestWatch monitor on the Cornell University website Nestwatch.org.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:40 PM by motion from Mike seconded by Wayne and unanimously approved by the Commissioners.
