Chairwoman Baxter: Ok. Is there anything you want to add to that?

Attorney Dan Flaherty: Very briefly. There's two petitions and they probably should be heard at the same time. The Warwick, Quaker Lane, Showcase already has a full liquor license and we've filed a courtesy petition to show that we are changing the location of the alcohol service, or expanding it into an actual bar area with restaurant food, sit down seats, etc. There really won't be any change in the use of the alcohol. Right now there is an alcohol service cart in the lobby. Alcohol is served out there and the patrons are free to walk in and out of the auditoriums. I have some exhibits. With the Warwick Mall, this will be a walk up bar only, and that's basically the type of bar it's going to be. They have a similar experience in Woburn, Massachusetts. I know that the most important thing with the Board of Public Safety is the safeguard against underage drinking. The Showcase has a very complicated and exhaustive safeguard checklist of everything to guard against underage drinking.

Chairwoman Baxter: So now patrons can buy a drink and go in and watch a movie, it's not just the comedy shows anymore?

Attorney Flaherty: Correct. That's what they already do at Quaker Lane. There is also a strict warning on any ticket stub; anyone using a false ID or having possession of alcohol will be immediately ejected. And furthermore, all of the persons serving the alcohol will be TIPS certified and trained and all of the ushers inside all of the auditoriums are equipped with something called monocular night vision goggles, so they will be able to walk in and out of the theater and see who has an alcoholic drink and who doesn't. The alcoholic drinks are served in small, clear, plastic cups. All of the other soft drinks are markedly different. They put a lot of thought into this and they have a lot of experience using all of the other places that have alcohol of this nature, including Providence Place, which was approved earlier this year.

Clerk McGovern: They've been doing this for a number of years already.

Attorney Flaherty: Since 2008 at Quaker Lane, correct, with no incidents.

Colonel McCartney: Is it my understanding that you're going to be having like obstacle courses out there where there is the potential for injury?

Ms. Hall: Yes.

Colonel McCartney: Ok. I just want to make sure that our Solicitor reviews that application also.

Ms. Hall: We have a full medical team that's been working with us for six years, just so you know.

Colonel McCartney: I understand that, but we can't preclude the fact that there may be some liability issues. I just want to make sure out of an abundance of caution to protect the City. You may face the same problem with DEM, I don't know because you're going to have to get their permission too.

Ms. Hall: We've been working with DEM for the past three years.

Colonel McCartney: I can't speak for DEM, maybe yes, maybe no, they own part of that property too. I'm going to at least ask our City Solicitor to review the application in case there are any liability concerns and how we've got to deal with it. We've got plenty of time to discuss it since the event isn't until next September.

Clerk McGovern: Have you been working with DEM on parking? Where's the parking? Are you going to be parking inside the lot?

Ms. Hall: We're going to be using the main lot inside. I've been working with Bobby Paquette and John Faltus. They gave me a number of parking spots, and I don't have that number off the top of my head, which should suffice for what we do. Normally, insurance wise what we do is we put additionally insured, State and City would be on our insurance liability. It's a one million, three million policy. It's what the State, whenever we work with them, it's what they require. So, I assume the City would want the same thing.

Colonel McCartney: If there are any outside parking problems, that's my problem.

Ms. Hall: Well the one thing that we were thinking of doing is hiring traffic detail.

Colonel McCartney: That certainly is a potential solution, because that's a real choke point down there.

Ms. Hall: I was thinking that myself.

Colonel McCartney: We have a lot of sensitivity in the neighborhoods, particularly on the other side there. Over in the Ogden Street area, we have problems there all summer long.

Clerk McGovern: There are also City residents who like to use that area on a daily, weekly, yearly basis. How many people are you expecting on either day?

Ms. Hall: The last one that we did on State property was at Scarborough and there were 1,200 people throughout the day. What we do is, normally what we do is put about 100 or 150 people through every 20 minutes of the hour. I would think we would be trying to cut down on those numbers a little bit to cut down on the traffic and cut down on the number of parking spaces needed. A lot of people stay. You know, it's a beautiful area; obviously they're going to want to, I mean it's a very family oriented event. There's kids races going on all day, and there's vendors. You know, that kind of thing.

Clerk McGovern: So are the vendors going to be inside the park or are they going to be outside the park?

Ms. Hall: Inside the park, on the grassy area. After speaking with Dan Geagan, he told me that the best idea for me at this point would be to talk to the people at the Chamber, but I wanted to come here first to make sure we got this all set...see what they did for movie nights, etc.

Clerk McGovern: He gave you good advice. That's what I would recommend as well, 1,200 people is a lot of cars.

Chairwoman Baxter: Yeah, we've gone to one of those and they really set that up very nicely. They did a real good job.

Clerk McGovern: Did they give you Lauren Slocum's name?

Ms. Hall: I don't have it with me but that sounds familiar.

Chairwoman Baxter: She's the woman that set up all of the movie nights. She probably can help give you advice about DEM too, because she's had to deal with them, obviously.

Ms. Hall: Ok. I also wanted to talk to the people who have the Rocky Point Foundation and make sure that they're heavily involved and making sure that, you know, we want to have respect for the land.

Chairwoman Baxter: Ok, great. What exactly, I've heard a little bit about it because I get emails about the ones you have at Yawgoo. What exactly do you do?

Ms. Hall: Well, we would do something very different at Rocky Point than we do at Yawgoo. Yawgoo involves digging mud pits and that kind of thing.

Chairwoman Baxter: You can't do that.

Ms. Hall: We can't do any of that. We've had, the last three dealings that we've had on State property have been on Misquamicut Beach, right after Hurricane Sandy, and then we've done Scarborough Beach for the last two years. Our plan is to do what we normally do there and that is lower our numbers, with respect to the land we don't want as many people trading through at the same time. No digging, and just creating a course that makes sense with the lay of the land so that we're not putting too much pressure on the land itself.

Clerk McGovern: So, when a contestant applies to be in this dash, do you assign a time for that person?

Ms. Hall: Yes, and we're very strict. We have bands, and we don't allow people to, we call it wave jumping. When you have your wave, that's your time to be out there. We also want to know who's out there and who's not. We have our medical team is usually on gators making sure that everyone has passed a certain point. We have timing chips, and things like that, so that we know for safety reasons how many people are out on the course.
