**By meeting all the requirements below, you will be eligible to take the written exam  
Must present with originals and photo copies of each**

- **\$50.00 Certified check or money order, payable to “Warwick Fire Department”**  
(Must be submitted at time of application)
- **Two (2) letter sized self-addressed envelopes**  
(Must be submitted at time of application)
- **Birth Certificate or US – INS for verification**  
(Must be a US Citizen at least 18 years old and not over age 30 at the start date of recruit school)
- **Rhode Island Firefighter Physical Performance Assessment Certificate**  
(Valid certificate at the time of the start of fire academy; not necessary to apply)
- **Valid Motor Vehicle Operator’s License w/ Photo Identification**
- **Driver’s Record**  
(Obtained within 90 days prior to application from the Operator Control Office – Registry of Motor Vehicles in conjunction with the state that issued the Motor Vehicle Operator’s License that is being submitted)
- **Criminal History Record**  
(Obtained within 90 days prior to application from the Attorney General’s Office in the state where the applicant resides)
- **High School Diploma or GED Certificate**
- **Must provide a valid Rhode Island Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), EMT-Cardiac or Paramedic License or; a National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) certification at the EMT, Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT) or Paramedic level prior to start of fire academy.(Not necessary to apply)**

Prior to employment, candidates shall be required to pass a BCI (Bureau of Criminal Identifications / Investigations) Check as well as a Medical Examination.
