Statement of Duties: Under the general supervision of the Collection System Program Manager and Superintendent will be responsible for supervising and performing inspection work during the construction, alteration, and repair of wastewater collection systems and septic systems, along with operating and maintaining televised inspection equipment. Duties will include but are not limited to: Preparing work schedules and supervising activities of field inspectors; inspecting layout of easements; conducting compaction tests of roads; assisting in engineering survey and layout work; coordinating work of utilities and contractors; coordinating with Industrial Pretreatment regarding commercial construction issues; advising property owners regarding connection to their property; assisting pretreatment technician in setting up samplers and flow meters in collection site; responding to complaints of backups; compiling and preparing reports; responsible for daily operation and maintenance of the CCTV Unit; updating the Capacity Management Operations and Maintenance (CMOM) database; assisting in preparing response comments on various construction related issues; supervising easement maintenance and record corresponding documents; operating instruments to transfer stationary benchmarks; operating flushing/vactor truck; must carry pager/cell phone and be available to respond to sewer backups; and performing related work and duties as required or assigned.

Education & Experience: High school diploma or general education degree (GED); supplemented with six months to one year related experience and/or training; or any equivalent combination of education and experience. Pipe Assessment Certification Program (PACP) certification and CCTV inspection experience a plus.

Special Requirements: Applicants must possess or obtain a State of Rhode Island Grade I Wastewater Operator License and a valid State of Rhode Island Commercial Drivers License within one year of employment or be terminated. A Driver's License check for the last two years will be performed; any negative findings may prevent applicant from being considered.
