**RULE 41.** After the Docket Session at the City Council Public Hearing meeting there shall be a fifteen minute period during which citizens may comment about Warwick city government issues subject to the following stipulations:

- a) The total period of time for public comment shall be 15 minutes. Comments need to be brief in order to allow as many citizens as possible to participate.
- b) The topics for comment shall be issues directly affecting City government.
- c) City Council members will not respond to questions during the public comment period.
- d) The public comment session will terminate at the expiration of 15 minutes or at midnight even if the full 15 minutes have not expired, whichever is earlier. Waiver of this provision requires unanimous consent.

**Gene Nadeau – Resents School Committee when he is referred to as ‘grandfather’. Directive on hold line of spending in newspaper. Eileen Naughton wants no testing for graduating. He disagrees. McCaffrey & Walaska want to keep contracts going when they expire. He disagrees. Wise contract went on for 5 years. It was to the detriment of the school Dept. Do we have the will and are we willing to handle our responsibilities when preparing budgets & re-negotiating new contracts? Debt exceeds 7 million dollars. We need to reduce it or go bankrupt. Representatives & Senators never come to school committee meetings. Rep Ferri only came once. Collectively all of us can make a difference. Millions can be saved in upcoming contracts. We have to stop this madness. Time is running out and we need to do something about it.**
