On the cover: The Warwick Animal Shelter, located at 250 Service Road off Jefferson Boulevard, opened in August 2003. The \$1-million facility, funded with voter-approved bond money, is a 5,350-square foot, one-story building made of concrete block and constructed in a T-shape.

It contains a cat room, surgery space, offices and a food preparation station. There are also 32 indoor/outdoor dog runs, one of which is a double pen for pregnant animals or strays that come in together. An additional six runs are in a special quarantine area.

#### 2008-2009 FORWARD

- I. The purpose of this City budget supplement is to provide the City Council with additional information concerning the nature and distribution of personnel costs. Detail for each City agency is reflected as follows:
  - (1) Job Classification
  - (2) Number of Positions
  - (3) Total Allowance (includes salary and other compensation items such as steps or longevity).
- II. Whereas City services are divided into two classes of employment (unclassified and classified), a general explanation of the personnel budgeting system is as follows:
  - (1) Unclassified positions established by law and governed by the unclassified pay plan
  - (2) Classified positions covered by the Merit System Ordinance
  - (3) Bargaining-Unit certain classified and unclassified positions are covered by state law on collective bargaining. Their salaries and working conditions are determined in accordance with the contractual agreement between the City and the Unions (Municipal Union [Local #1651, Rhode Island Public Employees and Council #94, A.F.S.C.M.E., AFL-CIO], the Firefighters Union [Local 2748, International Association of Firefighters, AFL-CIO], and the Police Union [FOP Lodge No.7].
  - (4) Exempt positions not included with the bargaining unit.
  - (5) Limited limited-period positions established to meet emergencies, seasonal requirements or unusually heavy workloads during the year.
  - (6) Grant Funded positions are those that are paid for by outside sources. They are usually short term and usually do not include all employee benefits. From time to time grant funded positions are added or deleted as funding and/or needs for such positions change.
- III. Please note that some positions in the Department of Public Works Highway Division and Building Maintenance Division have been previously shown in the Personnel Supplement at a rate lower than was actually being paid with the difference being shown in the line item entitled "Temporary Services". For the sake of consistency, those positions are now shown at the actual rate paid and the monies have been deducted from the "Temporary Services" line item.
