
City of Warwick Personnel Supplement 2013-2014

ON THE COVER: The Pawtuxet Rangers, or Second Independent Company for the County of Kent, were chartered by the Colony of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations on October 29, 1774, to protect the village of Pawtuxet, a thriving commerce seaport and fishing village. Today they are among the oldest existing chartered commands in the country, and still operate under their existing charter. They are among the most active of Rhode Island's militia groups and are one of only four fife and drum corps in the United States that are part of an actual military organization.

Although their original charter was issued in 1774, the Rangers had not owned anything dating to their Colonial existence. Late last year, by chance, they learned that a copy of the Charter, made by Company Clerk John Waterman, Jr., between 1777 and 1778, was to be auctioned. The Rangers quickly made a plan to purchase the document, which is presently being preserved and framed for continuous display in their home in historic Pawtuxet Village. A community fundraiser has offset the costs of the purchase.

The Rangers are constantly sought for participation in a wide variety of parades and public appearances, and are a favorite at the annual Gaspee Days, a two-month series of events that commemorate the nation's "First Blow for Freedom," when, in 1772, eight longboats traveled down the Narragansett River under cover of darkness to burn the British schooner, the *HMS Gaspee*, which lay grounded off Namquid Point in Warwick.

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2013-2014 FORWARD

- I. The purpose of this City budget supplement is to provide the City Council with additional information concerning the nature and distribution of personnel costs. Detail for each City agency is reflected as follows:
 - 1. Job Classification
 - 2. Number of Positions
 - 3. Total Allowance (includes salary and other compensation items such as steps or longevity).
- II. Whereas City services are divided into two classes of employment (unclassified and classified), a general explanation of the personnel budgeting system is as follows:
 - (1) Unclassified positions established by law and governed by the unclassified pay plan
 - (2) Classified positions covered by the Merit System Ordinance
 - (3) Bargaining-Unit certain classified and unclassified positions are covered by state law on collective bargaining. Their salaries and working conditions are determined in accordance with the contractual agreement between the City and the Unions (Municipal Union [Local #1651, Rhode Island Public Employees and Council #94, A.F.S.C.M.E., AFL-CIO], the Firefighters Union [Local 2748, International Association of Firefighters, AFL-CIO], and the Police Union [FOP Lodge No.7].
 - (4) Exempt positions not included with the bargaining unit.
 - (5) Limited limited-period positions established to meet emergencies, seasonal requirements or unusually heavy workloads during the year.
 - (6) Grant Funded positions are those that are paid for by outside sources. They are usually short term and usually do not include all employee benefits. From time to time grant-funded positions are added or deleted as funding and/or needs for such positions change.
