in honor of former City Councilman Joseph Gallucci**

WHEREAS: Joseph Gallucci was born in Providence on Feb. 9, 1935 and was a member of the 1953 class of Lockwood High School. A graduate of the University of Rhode Island with a Bachelor of Science degree in 1957; and,

WHEREAS: Joseph was a dedicated public servant, who faithfully served the people of the City of Warwick. He will be remembered for his soft spoken yet compelling leadership quality and as being a man with a kind heart who went out of his way to help others ; and,

WHEREAS: Joseph was a twenty-two year veteran of the Rhode Island Army National Guard; and was involved in many civic organizations including Continental Little League, Vince Lombardi Lodge 2357, and the Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in America; and,

WHEREAS: He served in a variety of positions for the City of Warwick; as the clerk of the Board of Canvassers and Director of the Department of Human Services and on three separate occasions he stalwartly served the residents of Warwick's Eighth Ward on the Warwick City Council; from 1977 to 1984, from 1990 to 1994, and from 2015 to 2018; and,

WHEREAS: He was the devoted husband to his late wife, Mary Ann Gallucci, the loving father of Frank Gallucci, Joseph Gallucci and Michael Ferruccio and the dedicated grandfather of Francesca, Joseph, Maria, and Joanna; and,

WHEREAS: In addition to his many political and civic contributions, Joseph dedicated his life to making Warwick the best place to live, work and raise a family; and,

WHEREAS: The City wishes to honor Councilman Gallucci's memory and recognize his commitment to our community, his stalwart and devoted service to the people of Rhode Island and his outstanding service to our Country.
