## BUCKEYE BROOK COALITION

The coalition was founded by Steve Insana in 2002. The Buckeye Brook Coalition is a state-designated watershed council. It was formed to focus on Buckeye Brook and its watershed, which covers much of central Warwick including Warwick Pond, Spring Green Pond, and Little Pond. The brook starts at the outlet of Warwick Pond and empties into the bay at Mill Cove.

Spring Green and Warwick Ponds are spawning habitat for alewives and blueback herring. Each year between mid March until late May the herring make their way from the sea through Buckeye Brook into the ponds to spawn. The major goal of the coalition is to protect and preserve the watershed to allow the alewives and blueback herring to fulfill Mother Nature's plan.

"Buckeye" and "buckies" are local terms for alewives and blueback herring.

## DO

**DO PICK UP AFTER YOUR PETS. DOG AND OTHER WARM-BLOODED ANIMAL FECES CAN WASH INTO STORM WATER AND THROUGH THE STORM DRAINS THAT EMPTY INTO THE WATERS IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOODS. THE ANIMAL FECES CONTRIBUTE GREATLY TO THE WATER CONTAMINATION.**

**DO LEAVE YOUR GRASS CLIPPINGS ON YOUR LAWN EVERY SECOND CLIPPING. CONSIDER HOW YOUR LAWN PRACTICES, SUCH AS WATERING, AERATING, AND RAKING, ETC. AFFECT NEARBY WATER BODIES. IF YOU MUST ADD FERTILIZER USE ONE THAT CONTAINS "0" PHOSPHORUS.**

**DO HAVE YOUR SEPTIC SYSTEM ON AN AGGRESSIVE MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE. A GOOD SCHEDULE WOULD BE A CLEANING EVERY 3 YEARS FOR A SEPTIC SYSTEM OR ONCE A YEAR FOR A CESSPOOL. USE WATER-BASED BIODEGRADABLE DETERGENTS AND CLEANERS. HOOK UP TO THE LOCAL SEWER SYSTEM AS SOON AS FEASIBLE.**

## DON'T

**DON'T FEED THE GEESE, DUCKS, SWANS, GULLS, OR OTHER WATERFOWL. ONE GOOSE CAN PRODUCE UP TO 700 LBS OF WASTE PER YEAR AND ONE DROPPING CAN CONTAMINATE UP TO 10,000 GALLONS OF WATER. IF THE WATERFOWL BECOME DEPENDENT ON YOUR FEEDING IT MAY HINDER THEIR ABILITY TO SURVIVE IN THE WILD.**

**DON'T OVER FERTILIZE OR USE JUST ANY FERTILIZER ON YOUR LAWN. NUTRIENTS CAN BE WASHED OFF YOUR LAWN AND INTO THE STORM WATER AND THROUGH THE STORM DRAINS ENTER OUR PONDS AND BROOKS. THE PHOSPHORUS WILL CAUSE AN ALGAL BLOOM WHICH WILL DECREASE THE OXYGEN LEVELS IN THE WATER.**

**DON'T ALLOW YOUR SEPTIC SYSTEM TO FALL BEHIND SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE CHECKS. WHEN CLEANING, DO NOT USE DETERGENTS THAT CONTAIN ANY AMMONIA, SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE, CHLORINATED SOLVENTS, PETROLEUM DISTILLATES, OR LYE.**



## DO

**DO** CONSULT WITH DEM (INLAND) OR CRMC (COASTAL) PRIOR TO ANY OUTSIDE HOME MODIFICATIONS IF YOU LIVE ON THE WATER. DEM OR CRMC WILL LAY OUT WHAT YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES ARE FOR THE PROJECT TO MEET THE GUIDELINES AND RULES OF THE CLEAN WATER ACT.

**DO** BRING THE PROPER TRASH OR GARBAGE COLLECTION CONTAINERS WHEN ON OR AROUND THE WATER. COLLECT ALL OF THE TRASH YOU HAVE GENERATED AS WELL AS ANY OTHER YOU FIND EVEN IF IT IS NOT YOURS.

**DO** SERVICE YOUR BOAT ENGINE ON LAND. IF YOU MUST SERVICE YOUR ENGINE ON THE WATER, USE THE PROPER CONTAINERS TO COLLECT ANY SPILLS AND TO DISPOSE OF THE WASTE IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS. COLLECT AND PROPERLY DISPOSE OF WASTE FLUIDS FROM YOUR AUTO, MOWER, ETC.

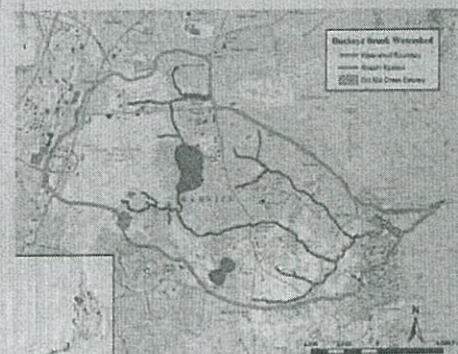
## DON'T

**DON'T** CLEAR TREES OR BRUSH, ADD A POOL, A PATIO OR A SHED WITHOUT CHECKING REGULATIONS. IF ANY OF THESE PROJECTS ARE NOT IMPLEMENTED PROPERLY THEY WILL CONTRIBUTE TO A DECREASE IN STORM WATER FILTRATION AND AN INCREASE IN EROSION.

**DON'T** DUMP OR DISPOSE OF TRASH, GARBAGE OR PLASTIC REFUSE IN OR NEAR THE WATER. IT WILL NOT ONLY CONTAMINATE THE WATER; IT WILL ALSO FOUL UP VESSELS' PROPELLERS AND COOLING INTAKES, AND KILL FISH AND AQUATIC WILDLIFE.

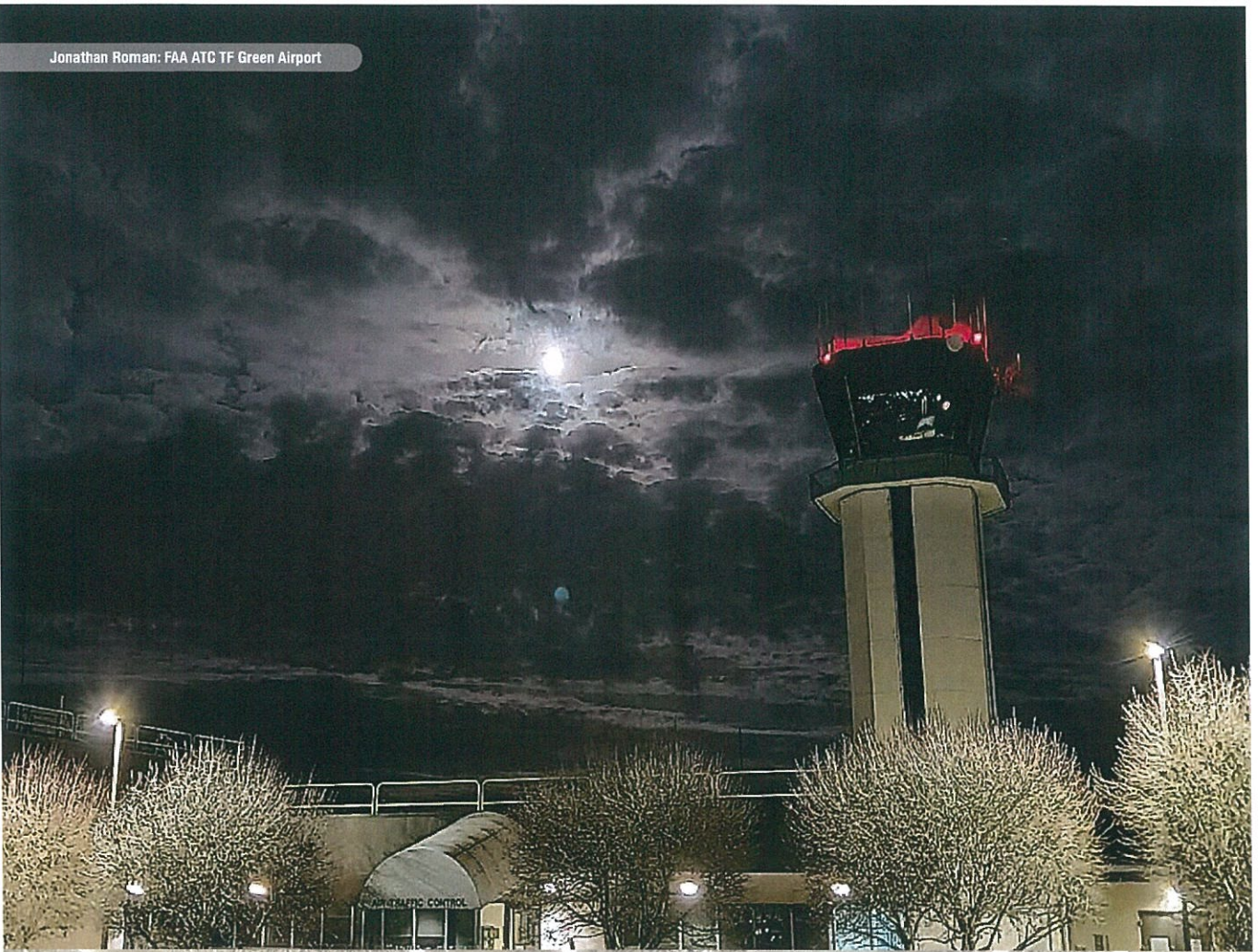
**DON'T** DISCHARGE OR SPILL GAS, OIL, OILY WASTE, ANTIFREEZE OR ANY OTHER AUTO OR BOAT FLUIDS WHEN SERVICING ANY ENGINES. DON'T USE PESTICIDES THAT AREN'T INTENDED FOR USE NEAR WATER. IF THEY ARE USED THEY CAN ENTER THE STORM WATER DRAINS AND BE CARRIED INTO PONDS, STREAMS, OR WETLANDS.

## MAXIMUM HOLIDAY RECYCLING

When the holidays are over, most Warwick residents have a lot of extra material to dispose of...all that crumpled wrapping paper and those crunched up gift boxes. Most of that gift-wrap is recyclable, and you can help! The week after Christmas, we ask you to give all that unwanted paper and cardboard to Warwick's mandatory Maximum Holiday Recycling Program. Don't let all that material take up space in the landfill when it can be used over and over again as recycled paper. We are asking all Warwick residents to join together to recycle their used gift-wrap, cardboard, and gift boxes.

Fill your extra recycling cart with wrapping paper and small cardboard boxes and put it out on the curb for collection, or you may drop off your recycling material at the Municipal Recycling Facility located behind the Mickey Stevens Sports Complex on Sandy Lane. (Closed on Saturdays, January-March).

- Use your extra recycling cart for the recycling of your gift-wrap, tissue paper, and small cardboard boxes.
- There are two kinds of gift-wrap that are not recyclable: paper and boxes that have a plastic or foil coating must be placed in the trash.
- Large cardboard boxes can be cut into smaller sections and placed in your recycling carts or may be dropped off at the Municipal Recycling Facility.
- Do not put paper and cardboard out in plastic bags.
- Please do not place non-recyclable items in your recycling carts.

Recyclable items can be dropped off Monday - Saturday, 7a.m. - 3 p.m.

## GIVE YOUR CHRISTMAS TREE BACK TO NATURE ~ RECYCLE IT

Christmas trees are due to be collected separately by the Highway Department the first two weeks of January, weather permitting. The trees will be collected on the same day as your regular trash.

Here's all you have to do:

- Put your Christmas tree out on your regularly scheduled trash day by 7:00 a.m.
- Remove all artificial decorations such as tinsel, garland, plastic ornaments, lights and bulbs.
- **PLEASE DO NOT PUT TREES IN PLASTIC BAGS, AND PLEASE, NO ARTIFICIAL TREES!**



The trees that are collected will be brought to the Warwick Municipal Recycling Facility, and faster than Santa can say "ho-ho-ho!" they will be recycled into mulch. The Christmas tree wood chips are available to residents free of charge!

## YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Warwick's yard waste collection program, in effect since 1993, collects grass, leaves and brush from curbside once per week in the spring and summer months, starting the last week of March, and every other week in the fall. Grass, leaves and garden debris must be placed in 50-gallon biodegradable paper yard waste bags or barrels. Branches must be tied in bundles 4 feet in length and placed next to your bags or barrels. Branch bundles must be no larger than 8" in diameter. Barrels must be no larger than 50 gallons and no bag or barrel may weigh more than 55 pounds. Please remove all dirt and rocks.

## GARBAGE

**Collected** - Larger items are collected by appointment only • 732-9589

**Household Garbage** - Must be placed in plastic bags.

**Lumber** - Must be bundled and tied under 4 ft. in length.

**Furniture** - Couches, tables, appliances, etc.

**Carpets** - Cut to 4ft. lengths or less, rolled and tied.

**Latex Paint** - For full cans, let paint dry completely. Add sand, sawdust, or kitty litter to speed up the drying process, and place in trash containers with covers off.

**Broken Glass** - Place in cardboard box, taped and labeled.



## NOT COLLECTED

**Contractors' Debris** - Sheet rock, plaster, roof shingles, insulation, etc.

**Hazardous Materials** - Call the Eco-Depot (State's Household Hazardous Waste Facility) at 942-1430 ext. 241 for a list of materials accepted.

**Miscellaneous** - Loose lumber, animal waste, ashes, sand, stone, cement, dirt, asbestos, oil, car batteries, gasoline, ammunition, etc.

**Loose Hypodermic Needles** - Please call for proper disposal methods.

**Computers, Monitors, Keyboards, Printers** - Must be dropped off at Recycling Facility.

**Furnaces**

**Box Springs and Mattresses** - Can be recycled at The Municipal Recycling Facility Drop-Off.

**Rigid Plastics, Pianos, Car and Boat Parts**

## MUNICIPAL RECYCLING FACILITY DROP-OFF

**Yard Waste** - Grass, leaves, branches up to 8 inches in diameter.

**Scrap Metal** - All types except gas tanks, oil tanks, chain link fence and propane tanks.

**Newspaper** - Place in paper bags.

**Bottles & Cans** - Plastic, aluminum and glass.

**Mixed Paper** - Junk mail, magazines, miscellaneous paper, etc.

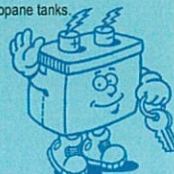
**Boxboard** - Cereal boxes, spaghetti boxes, empty paper towel rolls, etc.

**Cardboard Boxes** - Flatten before recycling.

**Tires** - Remove rims before disposal; rims may be dropped off as scrap metal. (Limit 4 tire maximum).

**Televisions & Computers** - Old televisions, computers, printers, monitors, any other equipment.

**Unpainted/Unstained Wood also accepted** - No plywood.

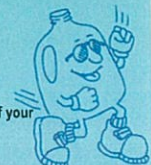

## AUTOMATION INFORMATION

### Automated Trash Collection

Using the automated system is easy! On your regular trash collection day, simply place your household trash into the wheeled gray cart (supplied by the City) and place it in the street with the lid opening facing the street. Your containers must be at least 3 feet from objects (including parked vehicles, fire hydrants, etc.) on either side and at least 4 feet apart from the other recycling bins. Your cart must be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Trash collection takes place once a week for every city resident. All bagged garbage must be placed inside the cart; if not, it will not be collected.

### Automated Recycling Collection

Each single-family residence participating in automated recycling has two wheeled carts, one blue and one green. In June 2012, the City of Warwick switched to a single-stream recycling program, which means you can now mix all of your recyclables together and no longer have to separate recyclables into blue and green bins. You do not have to follow the alternating blue/green weeks. You can now place either cart (blue or green) at curbside.

It is okay to mix your recyclables together. Paper can go in the blue cart; containers can be thrown in the green cart. We suggest filling one cart to the brim with mixed recyclables (make sure the lid can close), then start filling the next cart. Rolling out a full cart each week helps make our collections more efficient. If there is a need to put out the second recycling container, both containers must be full.

### No Cart, No Collection

What is "NO CART, NO COLLECTION?" Under the new "No Cart, No Collection" policy in Warwick, you must place at least one recycling cart at curbside alongside your gray trash cart in order for your regular trash to be collected. If you do not have your recycling cart containing the appropriate materials out with your trash cart, your trash will NOT be picked up. Recycling carts must remain curbside until trash has been collected. Any trash carts not collected due to non-compliance must be removed from curbside no later than 8:00 p.m. on the designated collection day, and set out for collection the following week with a recycling cart. Carts must be placed at curbside by 7 a.m. and after collection must be stored out of view. Only city-issued carts can be used for recycling collection.

### Bulky Items Collections (non-recyclable items)

What is bulky waste? Household items that are normally collected, but do not fit in the cart, such as couches, chairs, tables, carpets, painted/stained wood, etc. The collection of these types of items is available to all residents (by appointment only) and limited to five items per collection. The bulky items collection is for waste that is not included in the weekly, automated collection. Please keep large items away from the trash and recycling carts, as they will interfere with the automated collection of the cart.

\*Municipal Recycling facility closed Saturdays, January-March

### Bulky Items Drop-Off (recycle items only)

Bulky items that are recyclable should be dropped off at the Municipal Recycling Facility, which is located behind the Mickey Stevens Sports Complex on Sandy Lane. Items that are accepted include metal items (grills, bicycles, lawnmowers, metal lawn chairs, car parts, etc.), unpainted/unstained wood (fence, miscellaneous scrap wood, etc.) no plywood or particle board please. The facility is open Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.\*

### How do I schedule a bulky item pick-up?

When you have bulky items for collection, call the Automation Hotline at 732-9589 at least one day prior to your collection day and they will add your stop to the pickup route. These items should not be set out on the curb without first calling the Recycling & Sanitation Division to arrange for an appointment for their collection. Remember, before scheduling a collection, please check with a charitable organization to donate items that can be reused by others. Bulky items should not be placed at curbside until your regular collection day!

### Is recycling mandatory?

Please don't forget: **RECYCLING IS MANDATORY.** If you constantly run out of room in your gray cart, recycling properly will give you the extra room needed. For a list of recyclable items, please refer to the previous page. Gray carts that contain recyclables will not be collected.

### What can I put in the cart for trash collection?

Only bagged household trash can be put in your container. Do not place yard waste, brush, or any construction debris in your cart. Automotive parts, tires, hazardous waste and hot ashes are also prohibited. All trash must be contained in the cart with the lid closed or it will not be collected.

### How do I get large items collected?

You must schedule an appointment. Bulky items that will not fit in your cart such as furniture and other large items are picked up separately from household trash. Call the Recycling & Sanitation office at 732-9589 to schedule an appointment for collection of these items (three items max). Large metal items such as grills, bicycles, lawnmowers, lawn chairs, etc. should be dropped off at the Municipal Recycling Facility located behind the Mickey Stevens Sports Complex. Bulky items should not be placed at curbside until your regular collection day.

### What if my cart is damaged or stolen?

The carts are the property of the City of Warwick and each one is assigned an address and a serial number. All reports of damages or theft will be investigated and should be reported to the Recycling & Sanitation office at 732-9589. If our collection truck caused the damage, we will replace the cart at no charge to you. If the damage is from any other cause, the resident is responsible for replacement. Wheels, lids, and axles are normally replaced at no cost to the resident. Please DO NOT write house numbers or put any other marking on the carts. The cart is the property of the City of Warwick. If you move, please leave the cart at your home.

### Cart Maintenance

Warranty on trash and recycling carts is 10 years. These carts will be assigned to your address throughout this period. It is recommended to rinse the inside of your carts routinely to prevent odor and the attraction of animals.



## PAINT DISPOSAL INFORMATION

### 1. Buy only what you need.

Don't buy a gallon when a quart will do the job. One gallon of paint usually covers 300 - 400 square feet.

### 2. Use it all.

Use the extra paint for small projects or just put an extra coat on.

### 3. Donate the paint.

Someone else may be able to use your leftover paint.

Check with neighborhood organizations, Scout groups, friends, and neighbors.

### 4. Combine your leftovers.

Mix leftover latex paints together to use as a base coat or primer. This mixture is perfect for jobs that won't show. You may even end up with a color you like. If you are still left with old paint that you need to get rid of, please follow these easy steps:

#### Latex Paint (Full Cans)

If the can contains paint, you should uncover the can and let the inside dry to a solid. Adding kitty litter or sawdust will speed up the drying process. Once the contents have solidified, you may dispose of the can and its contents with the trash (lids must be left off).

#### Latex Paint (Empty Cans)

If the can is completely empty, you should uncover the can and let the inside dry. The empty can should then be left uncovered and placed in the recycling bin.

#### Oil-Based Paint (Empty or Full Cans)

Oil-based paint is considered a hazardous waste. If the can contains paint, you should contact the Eco - Depot @ 942-1430, ext. 241, to schedule a drop-off appointment. Do not dispose of the paint in the trash!

If you have other household hazardous waste, such as paint thinners, pesticides, solvents, pool chemicals, cleaning materials, etc., you can schedule an appointment to drop them off along with your oil-based paint at the Eco - Depot. Drop-offs at the facility take less than 15 minutes. No long lines, no long waiting!



## RECYCLE YOUR MOTOR OIL

Most people don't realize that motor oil never wears out: it just gets dirty! Recycling cleans the oil so it can be used again. Nearly 25% of used motor oil from "do-it-yourselfers" is now being collected in Rhode Island. With the inception of the oil recycling program, in 1988, Warwick residents have recycled over 300,000 gallons of motor oil, making Warwick the largest Municipal generator of used motor oil in the state. However, this is only a "drop in the oil pan" compared to the number of gallons discarded.

### Recycling Used Motor Oil is as Easy as 1-2-3!

1. Drain the oil into a suitable container with a tight fitting cap which can be used over and over. Drain the oil from the oil filter into the same container. **Never** mix other liquids with used motor oil.
2. Take the oil and oil filter to the Oil Recycling Igloo at the Municipal recycling facility which is open Monday - Friday, 8:00 am to 2:30 pm.
3. From there, the motor oil and filters will be recycled at an approved recycling facility.
