- 1. John Simoneau: Is an Independent and Warwick resident. Considers the Council to be a gateway to government and he feels ethics is a concern. Plans to attend Council meetings regularly. Wants to get to know all members of the City Council and would like them to get to know him. He would like to heal any hurt feelings resulting from his actions at the inauguration. Reads an anonymous letter he received, censoring the foul language in it, attacking him personally for expressing his opinions on the recent election results. The letter also invited/suggested him to attend a post-election ceremony to congratulate a certain councilperson, but he was unable to attend due to a prior commitment. There is an ethics form and a financial statement, which needs to be filed annually by council members. He reads this form into the record. He is concerned that a council member or members don't understand this and are not truthful. He hopes the council members will stop worrying about re-election and put the interest of Warwick taxpayers and residents first.
