

RFP #2023-066 Land Lease Winter Avenue – Telecommunications Tower

The Planning Department has reviewed the bids for RFP #2023-066 Land Lease – Winter Avenue – Telecommunications Tower. A review of the single bid received by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless finds that the vendor response met the criteria contained within the RFP and therefore the Department recommends that the City Council consider awarding the bid to Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless.

Approval of this bid will allow Cellco/Verizon Wireless to proceed, at their own risk and expense, with design, engineering and permitting for a replacement tower at Clegg Field. Such permitting will require additional approval from the Planning Board and City Council in accordance with Section 506 of the Warwick Zoning Ordinance. Lease area to be approximately 50'x 50' of land area.

Proposed Lease amount is \$2,000 per month/\$24,000 annually with a 2.00% annual escalator for a twenty-year term. The revenue sharing percentage between the City and Cellco/Verizon for additional tower tenants is proposed to be negotiated with the City.

Background and need.

A telecommunication tower was approved for the site in 1998 and has continuously operated to the current day. The existing tower served a dual function; as a telecommunication tower and as light structure supporting the recreation ball field at the complex. The tower experienced a fire in May of 2021; the damage from the fire required that the tower be removed. A replacement "Cell on Wheels" (COW) has been used to provide temporary service at the site.

All major wireless carriers have expressed a need for a tower in this area; therefore, to limit proliferation of towers, the City solicited proposals from both tower companies and telecommunications providers. The intent is that one vendor constructs a new tower sufficient to provide service to multiple carriers and City communication equipment, if needed.

The City has reviewed the property based on a number of considerations and determined that a new tower should be located as far from residences as possible in an area with the greatest buffer. The City is proposing a lease of ground space approximately 400' southeast of the current location (See attachment).

TAB 4 – Project Proposal

Submittal of Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Respondent") in response to Request for Proposals, City of Warwick, Rhode Island: RFP2023-066 Land Lease Winter Avenue Telecommunications Tower (dated May 25, 2022).

Narrative:

Respondent Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless proposes to enter into a lease agreement with the City of Warwick and construct a wireless communication facility in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in this proposal and in the Request for Proposal documents. The facility is to be constructed on land immediately adjacent to Clegg Field (122 Winter Avenue) in the Conimicut section of the City as illustrated on Exhibit A attached to the RFP.

Respondent proposes to lease an approximately fifty-foot by fifty-foot (50' x 50') area in the approximate location shown on the plans attached to the RFP as Exhibit A, in which it will erect a wireless communications tower for the installation of wireless communication equipment. The facility will include a fenced compound containing operating equipment, an emergency generator, and ancillary equipment. Respondent will design the tower to accommodate a total of up to four (4) wireless carriers (depending on permitting), including Respondent, in addition to the City's public safety installation, and will be such that neither the City, Respondent nor any other carriers will experience interference from each other's equipment on the tower.

The purpose of the installation will be to provide improved coverage and service to the City in the vicinity of the new tower. As Respondent has not yet been selected, the appropriate solution to achieve this purpose has not yet been finalized, and plans have not yet been fully developed. Accordingly, determination of the final configuration, including final location, tower height and type, will be made in consultation with the City, based on visibility, constructability, access, type of foundation required, structural and coverage considerations, and any other considerations required to achieve the stated goal of improved service in the designated area. Respondent acknowledges and agrees that it will be responsible for submitting detailed plans and specifications for tower and equipment, which shall be subject to the City's approval as provided in the RFP.

All design, construction and operation will be performed by Respondent and its contractors, and upon completion the entire facility (tower, building, site improvements, etc.) will be owned by Respondent. Respondent will not seek to transfer of ownership or any aspect of operations of the tower to the City, unless requested by the City. Project design shall be approved by the City, and as-built plans of the complete project shall be produced and provided to the City. Respondent will be responsible for decommissioning the tower at the end of the lease period and/or if at any time the tower is declared obsolete by the Vendor prior to the expiration of the lease.

Respondent's installation shall provide for installation of additional equipment of up to four (4) other carriers (depending on permitting allowance) on the tower and within the compound. Respondent will provide accommodation for installation of any municipal public

service/safety cellular and/or wireless equipment within the installation reasonably requested by the City, in locations mutually agreeable to the parties. Such installation shall be rent free, provided the City shall be responsible for the cost of procurement, installation and maintenance of the equipment, and utility consumption only.

Upon being named the successful bidder, Respondent will proceed in good faith to negotiate a lease with the City, to comply with all Lease requirements stated in Section III of the RFP. These requirements are consistent with Respondent's form lease and with lease provisions agreed to between Respondent and other municipalities around New England. If awarded, Respondent will provide a form Lease for approval by the City which includes all terms and conditions required pursuant to Section III of the RFP, and which shall be acceptable to the City, Respondent and Respondent's legal counsel. The rent to be offered is set forth in Price Proposal, included herewith.

The lease will provide that it be contingent upon the satisfactory completion of Respondent's due diligence, which shall include a title examination, environmental review, NEPA screening, geotechnical, local permitting and other site investigations as Respondent deems necessary.

As Respondent has not yet been selected, its construction plans, materials, labor hours, etc. have not yet been fully developed or calculated. Respondent expects a construction timeline of approximately three to six months, from beginning of site preparation work, through installation of equipment, to completion of installation and bringing the communication equipment on-air. The completion date for the project, however, is difficult to ascertain in advance as it is dependent upon the time involved in obtaining all required permits and approvals for construction activities. This timeline can be impacted by numerous factors outside of Respondent's control under normal circumstances, and is further complicated by potential delays related to the current pandemic as it affects activities related to construction and permitting. Respondent will endeavor to complete the project diligently from inception to completion subject to the above constraints.

Respondent shall comply with all requirements of Section II of the RFP, including:

- Obtaining all permits necessary to meet all applicable federal, state, and local regulations including approval by the Warwick Planning Board and Warwick City Council.
 - Performing a title search on the subject lot at Respondent's cost.
- Paying all costs associated with the permitting, design, installation, maintenance, operation and insurance of equipment and facilities; and performing all work in a good and workmanlike manner, that will not adversely affect the property, or any existing structure on the property, and not cause any other damage to the property or structures located on or about the property.
- Providing a Certificate of Insurance and copies of policies, which shall remain in effect during the construction and Lease Agreement term (with coverages in accordance with City requirements to be determined).

• Furnishing copies of Respondent's licenses to operate. Respondent warrants that all of Respondent's cellular communication systems' transmitters and receivers' frequencies shall not interfere with local radio, TV, local and regional public safety, national defense or other similar operations.

If successful, Respondent will provide a Certificate of Insurance, naming the City of Warwick as additional insured, and a Certificate of Good Standing from the Rhode Island Secretary of State, within ten (10) days of award as required in the RFP.

Respondent has enclosed all of the documents as required by the RFP and is offering terms which meet or exceed the minimum criteria in that:

- Respondent is able to meet all the mandatory requirements described in the RFP including all lease requirements described in Section III, and is qualified to carry out the obligations of the Lease Agreement.
- Respondent is licensed to provide wireless communications services in Rhode Island by the Federal Communications Commission.
- Respondent has vast experience in constructing, owning, and operating telecommunications facilities and working with municipalities throughout the United States and has the largest network of wireless services in the country.



Now that we are exiting the Buttonwoods facility, we need for Crown Castle to pull their line out of the building and splice it at the street pole in order to provide continued service to our other facilities down the line. Since Crown Castle owns the fiber line, they are the only company authorized to do the work.
