The City has two, term-life insurance carriers. AXA-Cross Insurance Agency covers all municipal employees with a \$50,000 basic life policy to include accidental death and dismemberment; and \$20,000 and \$10,000 optional plans paid by the employee. The RI Interlocal Risk Management Trust covers all sworn police and firefighters with a \$50,000 basic life policy; and some firefighter retirees who pay out-of-pocket for an optional plan. The City's contracts with both companies will expire October 31, 2022.

RFP 2023-132 requested proposals that will, for the first time, will put all of the covered members under one carrier. We received three bids. All three gave fixed rates for the three year term of the contract. Proposals were rated on the following criteria.

Cost to the City.	70%
Cost to employees purchasing optional insurance.	10%
Customer support services.	10%
Experience and financial resources of bidder.	10%

The Personnel Director evaluated the bids using a three point scale for each of the above factors, with 3 being the high score and 1 being the lowest. The raw score for each category was multiplied by the percent value, and added together for the final earned rating. (For example, a raw score of 3 for cost to the City was multiplied by .7, for a weighted value of 2.1.) Using this methodology, the three bidders scored as follows.
