As a senior planner in the Division of Planning and Development, I worked on a variety of projects involving open space and recreational land preservation and park development. Projects included protection of environmentally sensitive lands along the Wood and Pawcatuck Rivers, the Blackstone River State Park (including restoration of the 1835 Kelly House), the Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor, Earth Day activities, site visits and review of municipal applications for funding through the state Open Space and Recreational Area Development bond program, a management plan for Rhode Island's south shore, the 1991 State Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP), review of natural resources and open space/recreation components of all municipal comprehensive plans, the Trails Advisory Committee, and the North South Trail. Activities included liaison work with municipalities and private groups, coordination with other state agencies (including the R.I. Historical Preservation Commission, on which I served as the RIDEM Director's representative) and other RIDEM divisions.

When the federal funding ran out for my position in Planning and Development, I worked as a Greenways Planner for the Biackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor Commission for 16 months. In 1997, I returned to the RIDEM office in Providence and served as a Public Information Specialist in the Office of Technical and Customer Assistance.

As Executive Director of the PRA, a state agency, I was responsible for most phases of the authority's operation. Duties included initiation and/or investigation of complaints of River pollution and resolution of problems with local and state officials; arrangement and supervision of clean-up operations, both volunteer and professional; supervision of design, implementation and maintenance of Riverwalk projects; preparation of annual budget and activities reports; publicity and public relations activities, including publication of Newstream, the PRA's newsletter; preparation of grant proposals; completion of a management plan identifying potential riverwalks, cance access sites and significant natural areas along the River; and office management and supervision.
