



Claim for property damages to 109 baycliff Drive: Marc Paolilli

On Sepetmber  $30^{th}$ , at ~8:30 AM a section of the the tree located on Warwick City property adjacent to our home at 109 Baycliff Drive, Warwick, RI 02818 came down onto our property & caused significant damage.

The damage incurred is as follows:

- Electric & cable lines were ripped from the house causing a power surge & damage to the corner
  of the house where the lines were connected.
- The tree landed on and crushed our mail box

Unfortunately, it was left to us to:

- 1) Repair the damage to the corner of the house where the wires came down. This work was completed by myself. 0\$
- 2) Call the city to remove the tree. 0\$
- 3) Call an electrician to attach new wires onto the house. We were unable to produce multiple estimates for this, as it was an immediate need. This involved pulling a permit and getting an electrical inspector to the house in order for National Grid to reconnect us. It took three days for us to have the power restored (9/30 to 10/2). Electrician \$225.00 + Permit \$79.26 =\$304.25
- 4) As a result of the power surge, our washing machine sustained unrepairable damage & required us to replace it. We replaced it with the same exact model as we had purchased a year ago. Total cost of the washing machine, taxes & removal of damaged washer. \$789.86
- 5) We had to purchase and rebuild our mail box including the post. I personally did the repairs & would like rembursement for the materials. Cost of the new mailbox & post are \$38.88

#### See receipts attached:

This tree is extremely weak & the winds from the storm that day brought a section of the tree down onto our property. Exactly, one year and one day prior to this event, a different branch, off that same tree fell down blocking the road & knocking out the power. Our neighbors have been complaining to the city over the past few years to have the tree taken down. It is an accident waiting to happen. It could have easily come down on a car or a pedestrian. It is rotted & will eventually come down on one of our homes. Its unclear why this has not been taken down...?




