29		[The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the
30		meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates
31		a different meaning:]

33		Operate means to control the operation of a snowmobile or recreational off-road
34		vehicle.
35		
36		Operator Means a person who operates or is in actual control of a snowmobile or
37		recreational off-road vehicle.
38		
39		Recreational off road vehicle means a motorized or electronic vehicle designed to
40		travel over unimproved terrain including but not limited to minibikes, dirt bikes,
41		all-terrain vehicles, and any other three- or four-wheel vehicle regardless of type or design. This shall not be construed to include golf mobiles or golf carts, riding lawn
42 43		mowers, electric bicycles or garden tractors, which are not registered as farm
44		vehicles.
45		
46		Register means the act of registering a snow mobile or recreational off-road vehicle,
47		as defined in this section, in accordance with RI General Laws § 31-3-2.2.

Snowmobile means a vehicle designed for travel on snow or ice in a natural terrain steered by wheels, skis or runners.

(b) Registration:

- (1) All snowmobiles and recreational off-road vehicles must be registered with the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management as provided by state statute.
- (2) No person shall place, store, or keep any snowmobiles or recreational offroad vehicles that are not registered in accordance with state law upon public or private land, including any buildings thereon, zoned, or used for residential purposes.
- (c) Operations: Except when a state of emergency has been declared by the governor or the mayor allowing snowmobiles to be used on city streets, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a snowmobile or recreational off-road vehicle upon any roadway within the city limits, except on private property with the express written permission to do so by the owner of said private property.

(d) Enforcement:

- (1) The Warwick police department shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this section and to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement and enforce this section.
- (2) The Warwick police department shall have the authority to impound, subject to forfeiture, any snowmobile or recreational off-road vehicle found to be in violation of this section in addition to any civil penalties imposed by the municipal court, as a result of the illegal activity and operation of these vehicles.
- (3) No impounded snowmobile or recreational off-road vehicle shall be released until final disposition of all criminal and/or civil charges relating to the operation or storage of any recreational off-road vehicle, nor until proof of ownership and proper registration according to state statute is verified and applicable towing and storage charges paid.
- (4) <u>Upon order of a justice of the municipal court, any impounded snowmobiles</u> or recreational off-road vehicles subject to forfeiture may be destroyed by the municipality.
- (e) Violations and penalties: Any person who violates, fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 30 days or both for each separate offense. The continuation of such violation for each successive day shall constitute a separate

1	offense, and the person or persons allowing or permitting the continuation of the
2	violation may be subject to penalties as provided herein for each separate offense.

5	Section II: Chapter 42, Article I of the City of Warwick Code of Ordinances is hereby amended
6	by adding thereto the following section:

8	Sec. 42-16. Violations relating to impounded unregistered off-road recreational
9	vehicles and snowmobiles.
10	
11	(a) The municipal court is hereby authorized to order the destruction of any vehicle or
12	snowmobile impounded in accordance with Section 40-33 of the Code of
13	Ordinances.
14	
15	
16	Section III: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as
17	prescribed by law.
