The lots are set forth in the legal 25 description and on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A. 26 27 Subject to the following conditions and stipulations: 28 29 1. That the Applicant shall include elements of the City Centre Design Manual in the 30 Landscape, Buffering, and Lighting plan, that shall include streetscape improvements to 31 include but not be limited to sidewalk/bike lane-pedestrian access improvements and 32 lighting along portions of Metro Center Boulevard and Kilvert Street to create connectivity 33 to the City's Intermodal District (City Centre). 34 35 2. That the Zone Change shall take effect upon the Applicant receiving Preliminary and Final 36 Approval of the Land Development Project by the Planning Board and/or its authorized 37 designee, respectively. 38 39 Section II: The Clerk of the Zoning Board of Review is hereby authorized and directed to cause 40 said changes to be made on the Zoning Map and the Record Book of Lot Classifications. 41
