12	Be it ordained by the City of Warwick:

14	Section I. Chapter 46 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick is hereby amended to		
15	add the following:

17	Sec. 64-6. – Military time for city employees.		
18			
19	<i>Preamble:</i> The City of Warwick recognizes and salutes the continued sacrifices of its active duty		
20	and drilling reserve military. The stated purpose of Title 38 §4301 in the US Code entitled		
21	Employment and Reemployment Rights of the Uniformed Services Act is: "to encourage		
22	noncareer service in the uniformed services by eliminating or minimizing the disadvantages to		
23	civilian careers and employment which can result from such service". The reserve components of		
24	the United States Armed Forces, also known as the Guard and Reserve fulfill a critical mission		
25	for our country's Homeland Security by performing a minimum of 38 days of military duty per		
26	year which includes weekend drill status and two weeks training status. They are also responsible		
27	for augmenting the active duty (or full-time) military when necessary. City employees who		
28	continue to serve their country as members of the Guard and Reserve reduce their much needed		
29	down time by using annual vacation/leave or comp time during their monthly drills amounting to		
30	approximately 24 days per year for which the city should compensate these employees.		
31 32	a) The City of Warwick will provide 12 days of "Military Time" annually to each full-time		
33	permanent or full-time temporary city employee who is a member of the Guard or Reserves.		
34	permanent of rain time temporary city employee who is a member of the Guard of Reserves.		
35	b) The city employee must provide a copy of his/her Leave and Earning Statement (LES)		
36	following the date(s) requested for "Military Time" to have vacation or comp time restored.		
37	removing the date(b) requested for minutely time to have vacation of comp time restored.		
38	c) City employees who utilize "Military Time" will not receive their regular city pay however,		
39	benefits and time in service for pensions or seniority will not be interrupted.

41	d) City of Warwick "Military Time" may not be accrued beyond each fiscal year (July 1 to June		
42	30), may not be traded/shared with another member of the Guard/Reserve and may not be sold		
43	back to the city for any personal monetary gain.

45	Section II. This Ordinance shall take effect July 1, 2016 upon passage and publication as		

prescribed by law.
