25	Section I: Chapter 48, Article III of the City of Warwick Code of Ordinances is hereby amended

Sec. 48-117. – Prohibition on health insurance coverage after retirement.

 Elected officials whose first term as an officer of the city commences on or after passage of this section shall not be entitled to receive health and/or dental insurance benefits at any time following their retirement, resignation, or other termination of their term of office.

Non-union employees who enter service with the city on or after passage of this section, including any non-union employee of the school department who becomes a city employee by virtue of a consolidation of departments or transfer, shall not be entitled to receive health and/or dental insurance at any time following their retirement, resignation or other severance of service with the city. This section shall not apply to an employee that enters service with the City in a union position and then subsequently takes a nonunion position with the City, so long as the aggregate of the employee's service in the union position and nonunion position adds up to at least ten years of creditable service and so long as the retiree health and/or dental benefits provided to such an employee are no greater than those provided by the applicable collective bargaining

1	agreement at the time of his or her transition fro	m a union to a nonunion position. The term
2	"creditable service" shall be as defined in either	er City Code Sec. 60-31 or Sec. 60-311, as
3	applicable.
