AN ORDINANCE IN REGARDS TO MODERINZATION OF PUBLIC SAFETY  
EQUIPMENT

Be it ordained by the City of Warwick:

Section I: Chapter 20, Article II, of the City of Warwick Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding Subsection 20-65 as follows:

[ . . . ]

Sec. 20-66. - Fire Department Restricted Receipts Account.

(A) Pursuant to Chapter 20, Article V, Subsection 20-291 of the City of Warwick Code of Ordinances, the following is the fee schedule for the use of rescue vehicles and emergency services:

- (1) Mileage: \$34.51.
- (2) Basic Life Support Emergency: \$1,352.00.
- (3) Advanced Life Support Level 1: \$2,197.00.
- (4) Advanced Life Support Level 2: \$3,323.00.

(B) Restricted Receipts Account. The City Finance Director shall allocate funds received by the City for emergency services from the City’s general fund to a Restricted Receipts Account established for the purpose of acquiring fire equipment and apparatus. The Finance Director shall allocate thirty percent (30%) of the total revenue generated by emergency services per fiscal year, or one-million dollars (\$1,000,000.00/100), whichever is greater, to said Restricted Receipts Account. The balance of the Account shall not exceed the amount of five-million dollars (\$5,000,000.00/100). The funds maintained in the Restricted Receipt Account shall be used solely for the purchase of fire equipment and apparatus.

i. Any and all purchases made with the funds of said Restricted Receipt Account shall be done in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Rhode Island and

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4 Section II: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
