On 10/31/19 when I arrived for duty (1400 hrs) I received a request for a traffic study for Cadora Ave; the request brought forth is the customers who use the business and services provided by 650 Greenwich Ave are ignoring the parking lot and parking on the roadway making the roadway difficult to pass especially in the winter months. I also received pictures of the traffic parked on the eastern portion of Cadora (closest to Covington), in one instance a vehicle straddled the western portion of Cadora and the plaza leaving the passenger's side wheels and rear passenger's side portion of the vehicle in the roadway. Although the vehicle was parked illegally the roadway was still passable for an SUV type vehicle as well as emergency vehicles (fire apparatus and ambulances). It should be noted the roadway is very straight and unobstructed at this point allowing one to see oncoming traffic or pedestrians for quiet sometime before they encounter the issue.

I visited the sight a couple of times; the busiest time I noticed was on 11/7/19 at approximately 1730-1600 hrs. No vehicles were parked on the roadway and there were no problems.

Cadora Ave runs from Greenwich Ave eastbound then turns (about 60 degrees) and runs in a northeastern direction. The roadway is 1/4 of a mile long and the speed limit is 25 mph. The road is about 26.6 feet wide which is pretty consistent throughout the entire street, allowing each lane to be 13.3 feet wide above national averages and recommendations.. There is a fire hydrant on the 60 degree corner (by pole #1). There is about 191.1 feet from the corner of Greenwich Ave, east on Cadora until pole #1.

I recommend "No Parking between signs either side" be erected from the south-east corner of Cadora and Greenwich until shortly after pole #1. This will make it easier for emergency vehicles to navigate and access the fire hydrant in urgent situations. Attached to this report is a diagram of what I recommend.

I have tried to call Councilman Sinapi as well as Greg and Nancy Colombo in regards to this report and left messages.
