13	CERTAIN TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES WITHIN THE CITY OF

18	WHEREAS, there are currently several vacant stores, offices, and other commercial and
19	industrial buildings located within the City of Warwick; and
20	industrial buildings located within the City of Warwick, and
21	WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the City anticipates that further vacancies
22	are likely to develop; and
23	are interf to develop, and
24	WHEREAS, the City recognizes that these vacant buildings may diminish real
25	estate values of the subject property and of the surrounding properties and cause blight within the
26	City's neighborhoods; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, the City's Tax Revenue and is significantly linked to occupancy levels of
29	our Commercial and Industrial Tax Base; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the City desires create an economic incentive to assist the owners of these
32	vacant properties or units obtain tenants and modernize these buildings while at the same time
33	limiting blight; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, the City believes that the best way to provide such assistance is to
36	exempt any tenant that leases commercial or industrial space within the City that has been vacant
37	for two years or more, from the statutory requirements to pay a tax on their tangible personal
38	property for the first two years of occupancy. The City at its sole discretion may extend this
39	exemption beyond the two-year period if the owner or the tenant makes significant
40	improvements to modernize the property. This exemption shall not apply to newly constructed
41	buildings or be available to businesses relocating from one building within the City to another;
42	and

44	WHEREAS, the City will make every effort to assist our corporate property owners in an
45	effort to utilize or market their property for lease or for sale; but will consider issuing a non-
