20	(a)	The owner shall confine within a building or secure enclosure every fierce, dangerous, or vicious dog, and not take such dog out of such building or secure enclosure unless such				
21 22		dog is securely muzzled. At the boundaries of the property where the building or				
22		enclosure are located, the owner shall post signs that state a warning "Vicious Dog on				
24		Premises" in sufficiently large enough type to be read at a distance of six feet from the				
25		sign. The owner of every vicious dog shall adhere to all restrictions put upon such dog by				
26		the vicious dog panel.

28	(b)	Every female dog or other animal in heat shall be kept confined in a building or secure				
29		enclosure, or in a veterinary hospital or boarding kennel, in such a manner that such				
30		female dog or other animal cannot come in contact with another dog or animal, except for				
31		intentional breeding purposes.

33	(c)	Any animal described in the foregoing subsections of this section, found at large, shall be				
34		impounded by the animal control officer and may not be reclaimed by the owner, unless				
35		such reclamation be authorized by any court having jurisdiction.

37	(d)	Any dog or other animal may, the first time it is impounded for being a public nuisance,				
38		be reclaimed as provided in this chapter, but may not be reclaimed when so impounded on second or subsequent occasions unless such reclamation is sutherized by a court
