19	(a) Pool pass discount for Disabled Veterans			
20	(1) A Disabled American Veteran is a man or woman who served in the armed forces			
21	during a period of war or under conditions simulating war, were wounded and disabled to any			
22	degree or left with long-term illness as a result of military service and were discharged or retired			
23	from military service under honorable conditions. Persons utilizing the discounted pool pass			
24	program must provide proof of the disabled veteran designation and proof of city residency in			
25	order to receive the pool pass discount.			
26	(2) A Disabled American Veteran shall receive the following discount off the price set			
27	by the City as the fee for a pool pass:			
28	(i) a fifty percent (50%) discount for a Disabled American Veteran whose			
29	disability is determined by the federal government to be a disability of			
30	less than seventy percent (70%).			
31	(ii) a free pool pass for a Disabled American Veteran whose disability is			
32	determined by the federal government to be a disability of seventy percent			
33	(70%) or greater.			
34	(b) Fees for admittance to city-owned recreation facilities shall apply only to the summer			
35	season, beginning the third Saturday in June and ending Labor Day. Fees may be paid either with			
36	a season pass or at the time of each visit. The schedule of fees shall be as follows:
