14	ORDINANCE IN REGARDS TO AMENDING CHAPTER 40-30, PCO-8-18, SMOKING		
15	PROHIBITED IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND ON SCHOOL GROUNDS		
16	Be it ordained by the City of Warwick:		
17 18	Section I. Chapter 40, Article I, Subsection 40-30 of the City of Warwick Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:		
19	[]		
20	Article I In General		
21	Section 40-30. – Smoking prohibited in public schools and on school grounds.		
22	It shall be unlawful for any person <u>, of any age</u> , to use any tobacco products <u>, any</u> or any		
23	electronic nicotine delivery system, or any other substance containing or item containing tobacco		
24	in any public school facility building or upon school property. No person under the age of		
25	eighteen years may possess tobacco in any form or an electronic nicotine delivery system while		
26	in any public school building or upon school property. Violation of this section shall be		
27	punishable by a fine of one hundred dollars for the first and second offense by a person. The fine		
28	may be paid by mail or in person at the city municipal court. Upon the third and each subsequent		
29	violation of this section, a person shall be subject to the penalties set forth in section 1-4 of the		
30	Code.		

1	All violations of this section alleged to have been committed by any person under the age		
2	of eighteen years shall be referred to the juvenile hearing board. First offenders shall be required		
3	to successfully complete a tobacco abuse counseling program, the cost of which shall be borne		
4	by the offender. Any subsequent offense or failure to successfully complete the tobacco abuse		
5	counseling program impose for a first offense shall be punishable by a fine of not less than one		
6	hundred dollars or twenty hours of community service.		
7	Section II. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
