**RESOLUTION TO THE RHODE ISLAND FEDERAL CONGRESSIONAL  
DELEGATION AND AMTRAK REQUESTING THAT THE FENCE ALONG THE  
RAILROAD TRACKS IN WARWICK BE REPAIRED TO PREVENT  
ACCESS TO THE RAILROAD TRACKS**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, some sections of the fences along the railroad tracks are in disrepair; and

WHEREAS, there are some places in residential areas where there is no fencing along the railroad tracks; and

WHEREAS, in those areas where the fence is in disrepair or no fence exists children and other persons can gain access to the railroad tracks which can lead to injury or death for persons who venture too close to the railroad tracks; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is very concerned about a dangerous condition that exists because the fencing along the railroad tracks in the City is in disrepair or nonexistent.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests the Federal Congressional delegation and Amtrak to have the fence repaired along the railroad tracks in Warwick to prevent access by people to the Amtrak railroad tracks.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the members of the Federal Congressional delegation and to Amtrak.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
