**RESOLUTION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING LEGISLATION
INCREASING THE TAX EXEMPTION FOR THE JEWISH HOME AGED**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, by special act in 1930 the Rhode Island General Assembly established the Jewish Home for the Aged of Rhode Island as a corporation; and

WHEREAS, by a special act in 1953, the Rhode Island General Assembly provided that "said corporation may take, hold, transmit, and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding one million dollars which shall be and remain forever exempt from taxation"; and

WHEREAS, through inflation over the years the value of property held by the Jewish Home for the Aged has increased greatly but the amount of the tax exemption has not increased; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the General Assembly increase the tax exemption for the Jewish Home for the Aged to two million dollars.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby requests the General Assembly to increase the tax exemption for the Jewish Home for the Aged from one million dollars to two million dollars.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Senators and Representatives from the City of Warwick.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
