**RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING STOP SIGNS
ON SUBURBAN PARKWAY**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted by Officer Michael Isherwood of the Warwick Police Department at the intersection of Oakland Beach Avenue and Suburban Parkway, on or around October 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, said traffic study indicated that two (2) additional stop signs should be placed at the inside median of Suburban Parkway for westbound travel and also inside the median of Suburban Parkway for eastbound travel; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article 1, Section § 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place two (2) stop signs inside the median of Suburban Parkway: one (1) for westbound travel and one (1) and eastbound travel.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
