**RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING A FOUR WAY STOP SIGN ON
KENYON AVENUE**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, residents of Kenyon Avenue have expressed concerns regarding traffic and its failure to stop at the intersections of Kenyon Avenue and Franklin Street as well as Kenyon Avenue and Gillmore Street; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted by the Warwick Police Department on or around October 19, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study indicated that the east and west bound stop signs on Franklin Avenue were slightly obstructed by shrubbery and a fence, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study ultimately concluded that two (2) additional stop signs should be erected on Kenyon Avenue where it intersects with Franklin Avenue, such that a four-way stop is created.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that two (2) stop signs be installed in the area described herein.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director, and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
