RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO
PLACING A STOP SIGN ON CONN STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF
BLANCHARD AVENUE
AND
PLACING A STOP SIGN ON CONN STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF
BELLEVUE AVENUE TO REPLACE THE EXISTING YIELD SIGN

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that a dangerous situation exists at the intersections of Conn Street with Blanchard Avenue and Bellevue Avenue; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that:

- a stop sign be placed on Conn Street to control northbound traffic at the intersection of Blanchard Avenue; and
- a stop sign be placed on Conn Street at the intersection of Bellevue Avenue to replace the existing yield sign; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place:

- a stop sign on Conn Street to control northbound traffic at the intersection of Blanchard Avenue; and
- a stop sign on Conn Street at the intersection of Bellevue Avenue to replace the existing yield sign.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of
