## RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING STOP SIGNS AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS: (1) WADE STREET AT SUBURBAN PARKWAY, (2) OWENS STREET AT SUBURBAN PARKWAY, (3) OVERTON STREET AT SUBURBAN PARKWAY, (4) BURR AVENUE AT BAY AVENUE

## Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by Officer Matthew Caradimos of the Warwick Police Department which recommended the stop sign that is presently stopping the flow of south bound traffic towards the Oakland Beach Boat Ramp be rotated to stop traffic entering Bay Avenue from Burr Avenue (facing eastbound); and

WHEREAS, the traffic survey also recommended that stop signs be placed the intersection of Wade Street and Suburban Parkway, Owens Street and Suburban Parkway, and Overton Street and Suburban Parkway in order to stop traffic entering Suburban Parkway.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby directed to place stop signs at the following locations:
(1) At the intersection of Bay Avenue and Burr Avenue;
(2) At the intersection of Wade Street and Suburban Parkway;
(3) At the intersection of Owens Street and Suburban Parkway; and
(4) At the intersection of Overton Street and Suburban Parkway.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
