**RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING STOP SIGNS ON THE EASTBOUND
AND WESTBOUND OF PETTACONSETT AVENUE WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH
BUDLONG AVENUE**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted by Officer Michael Isherwood of the Warwick Police Department at the intersection of Budlong Avenue and Pettaconsett Avenue, on or around November 2 and November 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, said traffic study indicated that two (2) additional stops signs should be placed on Pettaconsett Avenue: (1) on the eastbound side and (2) on the westbound side at the intersection of the same with Budlong Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article 1, Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place two (2) stop signs on Pettaconsett Avenue, as described herein.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
