RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CITY OF WARWICK
LOCAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) has required that municipalities review and revise their local multi-hazard mitigation plan every five years to reflect changes in development, progress in local hazard mitigation efforts, and changes in mitigation priorities and submit their revised multi-hazard mitigation plan for review and approval by FEMA to remain eligible for pre-disaster mitigation grant funding; and

WHEREAS the City of Warwick Hazard Mitigation Committee was formed to draft revisions and updates to the City of Warwick’s Local Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan (“Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Committee, assisted by professional consulting services and funded by a FEMA Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant, has completed the FEMA required Plan update.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Warwick hereby supports the updated Plan and requests that the updated City of Warwick Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan be sent to the Rhode Island Emergency Management Agency for review and be sent subsequently to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for conditional approval, with final Plan approval to be by Resolution of the City Council and approval by the Mayor.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Rhode Island Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
