**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE INSTALLATION OF STREET AND TRAFFIC
SIGNS AT LENNOX AVENUE AND ROCKY POINT AVENUE**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the Lennox Avenue street sign was hit by a school bus and damaged; and

WHEREAS, the Lennox Avenue street sign has since been removed, but has not been replaced; and

WHEREAS, the Lennox Avenue street sign was previously used to identify Warwick Neck Elementary School, and its absence could potentially prohibit emergency vehicles from locating the Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Warwick Neck Elementary School is nestled between Lennox Avenue and Rocky Point Avenue; and

WHEREAS, a “DO NOT ENTER” sign at the Rocky Point Avenue entrance to the parking lot of Warwick Neck Elementary School was also damaged;

WHEREAS, said “DO NOT ENTER” sign has since been removed, but has not been replaced.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that the above-mentioned signs be installed in the areas as described.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
