A RESOLUTION TO THE RHODE ISLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
AND THE STATE TRAFFIC COMMISSION REQUESTING SAFETY  
IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF  
MAIN AVENUE AND SHARON STREET

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that dangerous situations exist at the intersection of Main Avenue (Route 113), a State road, and Sharon Street, which is near dense residential neighborhoods and an elementary school; and

WHEREAS, following dangerous traffic situations on Greenwich Avenue (Route 5) near Greenwich Cove Apartments (300 Greenwich Avenue) the traffic signals were improved by installing a yellow reflectorized border to the perimeter of the signals which enhanced visibility of the signals and resulted in better safety at such intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Warwick City Council desires that the State enhance safety at the intersection of Main Avenue (Route 113) and Sharon Street by installing traffic signal improvements to allow motor vehicles to pass safely and on to their destinations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby requests that the Rhode Island Department of Transportation and the State Traffic Commission enhance safety at the intersection of Maine Avenue (Route 113) and Sharon Street by installing traffic signal improvements such as yellow reflectorized borders to the perimeter of the signals.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the State Traffic Commission and the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Transportation.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
