**A RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ESTABLISHING ONE HANDICAPPED
PARKING SPACE IN FRONT OF 17 TOMAHAWK COURT**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article IV, Section 76-192(d) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, and if requested by the owner of a residence, may designate one parking space in front of a residence as handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, a request was made by Mr. Brian Bailey, owner of 17 Tomahawk Court via the Patricia A & Brian J Bailey T/E, seeking the installation of handicapped parking signage in front of such residence; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that handicapped parking signs be installed in front of 17 Tomahawk Court pursuant to the owner’s request and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to install one handicapped parking space in front of 17 Tomahawk Court, which shall be designated with two signs, no more than twenty-five feet (25’) apart, and in conformance with state law requirements for handicapped parking signs.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
