**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS  
 ERECTED SIGNAGE AS RESOLVED BY PCR-144-19**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2019, the City Council passed PCR-144-19, "Resolution relative to placing stop signs on Ridge Road and Cliff Road (Pyle Lane) at the intersections of Chapin Avenue and Priscilla Avenue and stop signs on Priscilla Avenue at the intersection of Palmer Avenue;" and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is required to erect signs and signals throughout the City, pursuant to Chapter 76, Article I, § 76-14 of the City of Warwick Code of Ordinances, when approved by the Warwick Police Department or the City Council; and

WHEREAS, all appropriate traffic studies were conducted by the Warwick Police Department, as required by Chapter 76, Article I, § 76-13(b) of the Code of Ordinances, relative to the above areas; and

WHEREAS, as a result of those traffic studies, the Warwick Police Department recommended that stop signs be placed in the affected areas; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick is a matter of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, one hundred and eight (108) days have elapsed since the passage of PCR-144-19, and no stop signs have been erected in the aforementioned locations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests, for a second time, that the Department of Public Works erect stop signs in the aforementioned areas.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director, and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
