**A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO PLACING A YIELD SIGN ON THE EASTERN END
OF BIRCH GLEN AVE WHERE IT INTERSECTS GORTON LAKE BLVD**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that a dangerous situation exists on the eastern end of Birch Glen Ave where it intersects Gorton Lake Blvd; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that a yield sign be placed at the eastern end of Birch Glen Ave to control the traffic entering onto Gorton Lake Blvd; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby directed to place a yield sign on the eastern end of Birch Glen Ave where it intersects with Gorton Lake Blvd to control traffic entering onto Gorton Lake Blvd.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
