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42	WHEREAS, Rhode Island General Laws § 45-36.1-1 et seq. empowers a city or town	
43	dedicate conservation land it owns as a public trust land in perpetuity in order to ensure	re

preservation of the natural environment and public access to the land for outdoor recreation and to

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ensure that the land is not converted to a use other than the use for which it was originally obtained 1 2 and remains predominately undeveloped and continues to provide open space; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Rhode Island General Laws § 34-39-1 et seq. grants a special legal status to conservation restrictions so that landowners wishing to protect and preserve real properties may 5 6 do so without uncertainty as to the legal effect and enforceability of those restrictions; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the City of Warwick depends on public confidence that the properties 9 conserved are held in public trust for conservation purposes consistent with the state constitution 10 and city charter and will remain permanently protected; and 11 WHEREAS, the Warwick City Council desires to protect the public interest by 12 permanently conserving Barton Farm (Assessor's Plat 251, Lot 179) as a municipal public trust. 13 14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby dedicates 15 Barton Farm (Assessor's Plat 251, Lot 179), as further described in Exhibit A which is attached 16 hereto and incorporated herein, to be held in the public trust, pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 45-36.1-1 et 17 seq., for the preservation, regeneration and restoration of the natural environment of the City of 18 Warwick; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER, RESOLVED, that the City of Warwick hereby deems Assessor's Plat 21 251, Lot 179 as having Conservation Restrictions as defined by R.I.G.L. 34-39-1 et seq. 22 23 The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Mayor, City 24 Solicitor, and Director of Planning, and to record this Resolution in the municipal land evidence 25 26 records. 27 This Resolution shall take effect upon passage. 28 29 30 COUNCILMAN SINAPI 31 SPONSORED BY: 32 33 **COMMITTEE: PUBLIC PROPERTIES**
