4 5	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and
6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, the RIDEM Office of Water Resources (OWR) implements a variety of programs aimed at protecting and restoring the state's surface waters, groundwaters and wetlands; and
10 11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, OWR has monitored the water quality of Warwick Pond for more than 20 years and reported its tracking to the local community in response to an outcry related to the blue-green algae that impacted all recreational use of Warwick Pond from August until November 2015; and
15 16 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, RIDEM explained that the causation and subsequent tipping point for this blue-green algae is not a single point of pollution but is cumulative and while discussing the environmental health of fresh water in the City of Warwick referred to in a 2006 Report where the City was notified of its impaired waters and required to address unsatisfactory conditions through the creation, implementation and monitoring of a Restoration Plan of Action.
21222324	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby requests RIDEM provide an overview of their initial evaluation of Warwick's impaired waters, including our progress on the Restoration Plan to date; and
25262728	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council also requests an update on the testing and capping of the Superfund brownsfield located at North Strawberry Field Road known as the former Leesona site, surrounded on three sides by Buckeye Brook which also travels into
