A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO ISSUING REQUESTS FOR PROPOSALS FOR  
AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT COMMUNITY PROJECTS

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Warwick City Council passed and the Mayor R-22-57 which adopted the City Budget for Fiscal Year 2023 and included an allocation of \$1,800,000 from American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for Ward Projects;

WHEREAS, the City of Warwick requested ideas from the residents for ARPA eligible infrastructure improvements to improve the quality of life in the Wards, including projects to enhance recreational opportunities, increase economic development, and for beautification projects;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that proposals for community projects in the Wards be developed and procured.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works and the Purchasing Agent are hereby directed to develop, in consultation with the Councilperson of the Ward, and issue requests for proposals regarding the following community projects:

- Ward 1, Pawtuxet Village, brick sidewalk repairs;
- Ward 1, Pawtuxet Park, comprehensive master plan;
- Ward 1, Sprague Field / Warwick North Little League, playground equipment replacement;
- Ward 3, Warwick Public Library / Cooper Building, Sandy Lane Apartments, Thayer Arena, LED pedestrian crosswalk lights and solar speed signs;
- Ward 5, Gorton Property – Webb / Draper, deterrents for off-road recreational vehicles;
- Ward 5, Tidewater / Lighthouse Estates, pedestrian / bike connectivity;
- Ward 5, Warwick Neck School, school zone / speed limit flashers;
- Ward 6, Suburban Parkway, fiberglass replacement flag pole;

- Ward 6, City Park Dog Park, park benches;
- Ward 7, Arnolds Neck, multi-person swing set with one baby swing, playground safety surface materials and installation;
- Ward 7, Gorton Pond / Arnold’s Neck / Nausauket; Apponaug Village, benches and picnic tables;
- Ward 9, Love Lane / Cowesett Road / Diamond Hill Road, solar powered speed display signage.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Departments of Public Works and the Purchasing Agent.
