**RESOLUTION TO THE RHODE ISLAND FEDERAL CONGRESSIONAL
DELEGATION AND AMTRAK REQUESTING THAT THE FENCE BE
REPAIRED AT THE END OF DUANE STREET TO PREVENT
ACCESS TO THE RAILROAD TRACKS**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Duane Street ends at the Amtrak railroad tracks; and

WHEREAS, the fence at that location is not secure and persons can gain access to the railroad tracks at that location because the fence separating the street from the railroad tracks needs to be repaired; and

WHEREAS, last year a person was injured when that person gained access to the railroad tracks because the fence at that location is in disrepair, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is very concerned about the dangerous condition that exists on Duane Street at the railroad tracks.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests the Federal Congressional delegation and Amtrak to have the fence repaired at the end of Duane Street to prevent access by people to the Amtrak railroad tracks at that location.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the members of the Federal Congressional delegation and to Amtrak.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
