19	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are
20	matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

22	WHEREAS, Duane Street ends at the Amtrak railroad tracks; and
23	WHEREAS, the fence at that location is not secure and persons can gain access to the
24 25	railroad tracks at that location because the fence separating the street from the railroad tracks needs
25 26	to be repaired; and

28	WHEREAS, last year a person was injured when that person gained access to the railroad
29	tracks because the fence at that location is in disrepair, and

31	WHEREAS, the City Council is very concerned about the dangerous condition that exists on
32	Duane Street at the railroad tracks.
