18	WHEREAS, Governor Raimondo is proposing that the RI Veteran's Home's 200
19	residents be required to pay one hundred percent (100%) of their monthly income to live there,
20	compared to the current eighty percent (80%); and

22	WHEREAS, this is equivalent to an approximate \$625.00 per month increase; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the Governor is attempting to justify the increased cost, in part, by stating
25	that veterans will receive an increase to their monthly stipend, from \$150.00 to \$300.00; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, under this proposal, the State would take \$625.00 more a month, but only
28	give back \$150.00, which is merely twenty-four (24%) of the proposed increase; and

30	WHEREAS, this proposal is a thin-veiled attempt to take earned Federal benefits from
31	the State's disabled veterans in an effort to cover mismanagement and unchecked spending.
