13	FY2019 LEVELS TO MUNICIPALITIES AS SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATION AID

16 17	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Warwick are matters of
18	paramount importance to the City Council; and

20	WHEREAS, investment in elementary and secondary education is critical to strengthening
21	communities, invigorating the economy, and improving quality of life; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, Article XII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the State of Rhode Island
24 25	provides that it is the duty of the General Assembly to promote public schools and to secure to the people the advantages and opportunities of education; and
26	people the advantages and opportunities of education, and
27	WHEREAS, in recent years the state expanded gambling options in the state by, among
28	other forms, authorizing Table Gaming, establishing a second casino, opening retail sports books,
29	and launching remote sportsbook via application and the internet; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the state lottery transferred \$302 million to the state's General Fund in
32 33	FY2021, an increase above the \$284 million transferred in FY2020, but significantly reduced from the pre-Covid-19 FY2019 transfer of \$398 million; and
33 34	the pre-covid-191/12019 transfer of \$598 minion, and
35	WHEREAS, the November 2021 state Revenue Estimate Conference increased the
36	FY2022 lottery transfer projections by \$17 million to \$393 million; and
37	
38	WHEREAS, shortfalls in state funding for education exacerbate the property tax burden
39	imposed by local government on residents and businesses in order to fulfill municipal education
40	obligations from the state; and
41 42	WHEDEAS EV2022 state advection aid antitlements to the City of Werwiels containstance
42 43	WHEREAS, FY2022 state education aid entitlements to the City of Warwick contributes less than 25% of the funding required for the City's \$174 million FY2022 school budget; and
43 44	less than 2576 of the funding required for the City's \$174 minion 1 12022 sendor budget, and

1	WHEREAS, the Warwick City Council desires that the General Assembly appropriate to
2	municipalities a portion of additional state gambling revenues in excess of FY2019 levels in the
3	form of supplemental education aid so as to provide municipal property tax relief.
4	
5	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Warwick City Council hereby respectfully
6	requests the General Assembly to enact legislation providing municipal property tax relief by
7	appropriating at least ten percent (10%) of additional state gambling revenues in excess of FY2019
8	levels to municipalities as supplemental education aid.
9	
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk send a copy of this Resolution to the
11	City's Representatives and Senators in the Rhode Island General Assembly.
12	
13	This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
