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15	WHEREAS, the City of Warwick (the "City") desires to establish an OPEB trust fund
16	pursuant to the relevant provisions of R.I.G.L. § 45-21-65, as amended; and
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18	WHEREAS, pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 45-5-20.2 the Rhode Island Interlocal Risk
19	Management Trust has established an OPEB Funding Program (the "Program") designed to fund
20	post-employment benefits for the City's employees as specified in the City's policies and/or
21	applicable collective bargaining agreements; and
22 23	WHEREAS, the City is eligible to participate in the Program; and
24	WHEREAS, the City is engible to participate in the Hogram, and
25	WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the best interest of the City to adopt the Public
26	Agencies Post-Retirement Health Care Plan Trust, a multiple employer tax-exempt trust
27	performing an essential governmental function within the meaning of Section 115 of the Internal
28	Revenue Code, as amended, and the relevant statutory provisions of the State of Rhode Island; and
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30	WHEREAS, the City's adoption and operation of the Program has no effect on any current
31	or former employee's entitlement to other post-employment benefits; and
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33	WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of post-employment benefit entitlement, if any, are
34	governed by contracts separate from and independent of the Program; and
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36	WHEREAS, the City's funding of the Program does not, and is not intended to, create any
37	new vested right to any benefit nor strengthen any existing vested right; and
38	WHERE AS the City reserves all rights to make contributions if any to the Programs and
39 40	WHEREAS, the City reserves all rights to make contributions, if any, to the Program; and
40	WHEREAS, although state law permits public entities to establish trusts and this Program
42	for the purposes of funding post-employment benefits, any employer participating in the Program
43	or participant in such Program shall hold harmless the State of Rhode Island and/or its agents,

employees, and servants from any cause of action arising from the administration of or 1 2 participation in the Program. 3 4 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby approves participating in the OPEB Funding Program established by the Rhode Island Interlocal Risk 5 6 Management Trust. 7 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby adopts the Public Agencies Post-Retirement Health Care Plan, effective December 20, 2021 (the "Trust"). 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby appoints the City Treasurer 11 or his/her successor or his/her designee as the City's Plan Administrator for the Trust. The Plan 12 Administrator shall act on behalf of the City in all matters relating to the City's participation in the 13 Trust, including, but not limited to, authorizing the investment of assets in the Trust, providing 14 directions to the Trustee and/or the Trust Administrator, and authorizing disbursements from the 15 City's trust assets, and the City shall, pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 45-15-6, indemnifying said Plan 16 17 Administrator. 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby delegates the oversight of the investment management of the City's funds placed into the Program to the Rhode 20 Island Interlocal Risk Management Trust's Board of Trustees. 21 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City's Plan Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the legal and administrative documents on behalf of the City and to take whatever 24 additional actions are necessary to maintain the City's participation in the Trust and to maintain 25 compliance of any relevant regulations issued or as may be issued. 26 27 28 This Resolution shall take effect upon passage. 29 30 SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL PRESIDENT MCALLISTER 31 ON BEHALF OF MAYOR PICOZZI
