RESOLUTION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY REQUESTING A RESOLUTION TO
NATIONAL GRID REGARDING ELECTRICAL WIRES NEAR NORTON’S MARINA

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the Warwick City Council; and,

WHEREAS, the electrical wires from Division Road that run across the access road to Norton’s Marina are very low; and,

WHEREAS, last year two young people were electrocuted and hospitalized when the mast on their sailboat struck the wires; and,

WHEREAS, similar incidents have occurred in recent years; and

WHEREAS, the low electrical wires present a very dangerous condition.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby requests the General Assembly to pass a Resolution requesting National Grid to either move the electrical wires or insulate them so that the dangerous condition is removed.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Senators and Representatives from the City of Warwick.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
